PERFECTLY NORMAL.**



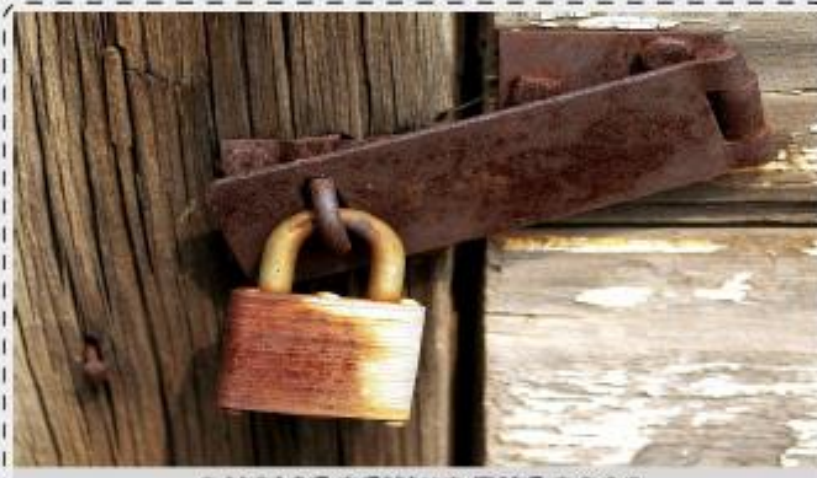
NOBODY EVER SAW HER FACE.
